EVENT FEES

Event fees are \$35 for U16+ and \$24 for U14 and lower for each day of racing. Racers and coaches will also need to buy a \$20 trail pass good for the race weekend (Friday/Saturday/Sunday).

VENUE

All races will be held at the Frontier Point Nordic Lodge and Norwaiver for the Bogus JNQdic Trails at Bogus Basin Mountain Resort, 15 miles from Boise, ID. Allow for ~45min drive time from Boise. Immediate parking adjacent to the Nordic Center will be reserved for team vans and race crews. There should be ample parking in the main downhill parking lot. We expect parking issues to be manageable this time of year however always best to carpool and limit extra vehicles. More info will be provided during race check-in Friday, February 3rd.

Limited power will be available in the team waxing area via extension cords supplemented with generator power. We recommend those traveling within IMD bring generators if available.
